Filipa Pato & William Wouters Nossa Calcário Bical 2021, Bairrada, AUD \$72

This wine, from an exciting new producer in Portugal's Bairrada region, was made from the local bical grape, fermented and matured in 500 and 600 litre barrels.

The colour is deep golden-yellow and it has a smoked chicken/chicken stock bouquet, a kiss of toasty oak in the background, the palate rich and complex with amplitude, roundness and good persistence. An impressive full-bodied wine, with a dry-but-soft balance. Think chardonnay from Burgundy with a touch of funk. (Cork)
