Production, Vinification technics:

The bunches are handpicked and hand-selected from our centenary vineyards in Bairrada (3 to 4 bunches/vine). Partly destemmed, fermented in open oak "lagares" with some extraction (pigéage). After fermentation, the wine is aged in 500-600 l used "pipas".

Origin and classification:

Bairrada DOC from Portugal.

Soil/Climate, etc.:

Chalky clay midslopes from the Jurassic Inferior with eastern orientation to the sun and a very intense Atlantic influence (we are only 15 km from the ocean). For this wine, the grapes come from different small plots of our oldest vineyards (80–130 years old). These 3 centenary vineyards we bought some years ago, are fully converted to biodynamics.

Winemaker's Notes:

Inspired by the viticulture of Filipa's grandmother, these vineyards are the real heritage of the region. They give an exceptional complexity to the wine, thanks to the expression of the Baga grape from different and well-defined locations. When you work in centenary vineyards with Biodynamic practice, you really understand the notion of "un grand terroir".

Colour:

Bright intense dark cherry red colour with a ruby rim and great viscosity.

Bouquet:

The aromas are very pure dominated by violets, strawberries and subtle smokiness, a bit of spice when the wine is young. After 5 to 7 years, the aromas get more complex, extremely energetic and with good concentration.

Taste:

The wine is almost generous with an intense structure and richness in harmony with the fine and noble tannins. It is neither too rough nor too heavy, the body has an extremely silky texture and the acidity brings energy and liveliness. The aftertaste is a pure delight.

Gastronomic Accompaniments:

A great wine for gastronomy! Simply cooked high-quality meats (lamb, beef, veal, pigeon, duck, pheasant, partridge, hare, fillet of deer). We imagine also sweetbread, veal kidney and even calves liver (Venetian way with glazy onions). Strong cheeses will give a good match too (Ami de Chambertin, buttery Niza, buttery Castelo Branco, Serpa).

Recommended further maturing (by the consumer, months):

9-35 years.
