The 2021 Post-Quercus is an unoaked Baga that is fermented and aged in uncoated amphorae. It comes in at 12.3% alcohol, which for this wine is a lot, based on what I've been told before. That doesn't change the final verdict, though. This is still on the lighter and fresher side. It still has some of that earthiness associated with an amphora. It tastes great overall and goes down easy. What seals the deal here and makes this hard to resist is that juicy, enlivening finish. You can't call this a profound Baga, but it sure is a popular one. It should age throughout most of the decade, more or less, but aging this is not really necessary this year.
